SITE/PROCESS DESCRIPTION: The unit is an above ground tank used for surge protection. It is part of a system that produced HF for the feed facility.

WASTE DESCRIPTION: Possible presence of chromium.

WASTE QUANTITY: Unknown

DESCRIPTION OF RELEASE: Stains on the ground under the tank indicate that material from the tank has been released to the ground.

DOCUMENTATION OF NO RELEASE: N/A

RFI NECESSARY: YES - Initial sampling of material in the tank indicates chromium maybe present. The material is being resampled due to inconsistencies in the results.
