UNIT NAME: C-751 Fuel Facility

REGULATORY STATUS: AOC

LOCATION: Inside plant security fence, immediately south of C-720 building.

APPROXIMATE DIMENSION: Two 10,000-gallon underground storage tanks.

FUNCTION: Fuel facility for gasoline and diesel

OPERATIONAL STATUS: Temporarily shutdown for modifications

DATES OPERATED: June 92 thru present.

SITE/PROCESS DESCRIPTION: The fuel facility consist of two underground storage tanks, piping system, fuel pumps, and a small service building. The USTs store gasoline and diesel.

WASTE DESCRIPTION: 1,1 Dichloroethane

WASTE QUANTITY: Unknown

DESCRIPTION OF RELEASE: Analytical results have identified the presence of 1,1 Dichloroethane in the observation well/sump located between the USTs. The 1,1 Dichloroethane was released in the area during initial construction when it was used as a solvent for repairs made to one of the USTs.

DOCUMENTATION OF NO RELEASE: N/A
