BRIEF HISTORY: According to USEC operations personnel presently assigned to C-310, this area was established before 1996 to store waste related to PCB activities in the building.

OPERATIONAL STATUS: Active - currently not in use

DATES OPERATED: Before 1996 to 4/28/2000 (closure date according to the WESKEM, LLC GSA/SAA database).

SITE/PROCESS DESCRIPTION: Temporary storage of PCB contaminated wastes. According to USEC operations personnel, this area was managed in accordance with applicable regulatory requirements.

WASTE DESCRIPTION: According to USEC operations personnel, this SWMU contained PCB contaminated solids such as rags.

WASTE QUANTITY: None as of December 2000. According to USEC operations personnel, this SWMU contained one 55-gallon drum (7.4 ft³) for solid PCB waste storage. The waste quantity was not static since waste was routinely added to the container, and moved out of the area for off-site shipment or disposal.

DESCRIPTION OF RELEASE AND MEDIA AFFECTED: According to USEC operations personnel, there have been no releases to the environment from this SWMU.
