BRIEF HISTORY: According to USEC Power Operations personnel, this portable storage building was established specifically to store waste oil.

OPERATIONAL STATUS: Active.

DATES OPERATED: 12/1/90 – present according to WESKEM, LLC GSA/SAA database

SITE/PROCESS DESCRIPTION: Shields brand metal storage building for the storage of waste oils.

WASTE DESCRIPTION: Waste oil, including PCB oil.

WASTE QUANTITY: One 55-gallon drum as of 1/4/00. According to USEC Power Operations personnel, the maximum quantity stored here was five 55-gallon drums. The waste quantity is not static since waste is routinely added to the storage area or into individual containers. In addition, waste containers are routinely moved out of the area for off-site shipment or disposal (other drums depicted in photo are empty).

DESCRIPTION OF RELEASE AND MEDIA AFFECTED: According to USEC Power Operations personnel, there have been no releases to the environment from this SWMU.
