LOCATION: Parking lot south of C-611-U

APPROXIMATE DIMENSION: 7 ft. X 11 ft. as of 1/8/01. According to USEC Utilities personnel, the maximum dimensions of this SWMU were 7 ft. X 22 ft.

FUNCTION: Generator Staging Area (GSA)

BRIEF HISTORY: According to USEC Utilities personnel, this SWMU was established to store discarded equipment on pallets and used oil in drums. Most of the waste has been moved to DMSA Outside 03.

OPERATIONAL STATUS: Active.

DATES OPERATED: According to USEC Utilities personnel, this area has operated from early 1990s to present.

SITE/PROCESS DESCRIPTION: Storage of discarded equipment on pallets and used oil, non-RCRA rags and absorbents in drums.

WASTE DESCRIPTION: Discarded equipment, empty drums, used oil, rags, and absorbent.

WASTE QUANTITY: Seven 55-gallon drums and 2 containment pans as of 1/8/01. According to USEC Utilities personnel, 2 fuel oil tanks were also stored here and the average quantity was six to eight 55-gallon drums. The waste quantity is not static since waste is routinely added to the storage area or into individual containers. In addition, waste containers are routinely moved out of the area for off-site shipment or disposal.

SUMMARY OF ENVIRONMENTAL SAMPLING DATA: None

DESCRIPTION OF RELEASE AND MEDIA AFFECTED: According to USEC Utilities personnel, there have been no releases to the environment from this SWMU.
