FUNCTION: Generator Staging Area (GSA)

BRIEF HISTORY: **The mobile tanker was used to store decontamination water generated during a Department of Justice (DOJ) ordered excavation at the C-746-S landfill. The excavation occurred from 1/7/00 through 1/19/00. The tank was kept at the excavation site during decontamination activities, and moved to C-755-A-01 at night to prevent freezing. On 1/13/00, a fire at C-755-A-01 damaged the tank causing eventual disposal of the tank. In June 2001, two GSAs were established to temporarily house spent fluorescent light bulbs, spent oil, oily rags, and oil filters.**

DATES OPERATED: G-755-A-01: 1/8/00-1/13/00
G-755-A-02 & G-755-A-03: June 2001 - present

SITE/PROCESS DESCRIPTION: The 1,000 gallon mobile polyethylene tank was used for storage of decontamination water from an excavation project at the C-746-S landfill. The spent fluorescent light bulbs, spent oil, oily rags, and oil filters are generated from equipment and facility maintenance.

WASTE DESCRIPTION: Currently this SWMU contains: spent fluorescent light bulbs, spent oil, oily rags, and oil filters.

WASTE QUANTITY: Two (2) 30-gallon drums, a 200 gallon polyethylene tank for the spent oil, and two 4 foot cardboard boxes for the spend fluorescent light bulbs.
