BRIEF HISTORY: This SAA was created to store PCB contaminated oil. USEC operations personnel provided this information.

OPERATIONAL STATUS: Active

DATES OPERATED: The GSA/SAA database managed by WESKEM, LLC indicates this GSA was opened 10/1/98. However, conversations with USEC environmental personnel indicate that new inspection and tracking requirements were established on this date, and are probably reflected as the "open" date in the WESKEM, LLC database. The actual start of operation of this GSA, according to USEC operations personnel, was the early to mid 1990s.

SITE/PROCESS DESCRIPTION: Temporary storage area for PCB contaminated wastes. This area has been managed in accordance with applicable regulatory requirements since inception.

WASTE DESCRIPTION: PCB contaminated oil.

WASTE QUANTITY: 5-gallon capacity as of 12/12/00.

DESCRIPTION OF RELEASE AND MEDIA AFFECTED: According to USEC operations personnel, there have been no releases from this SAA to the environment.
